CODE OF ETHICS

 (d) Members shall not obtain any business by means of fraudulent statements or by use of implications unwarranted by fact or reasonable probability.
 (e) Members shall comply both in spirit and in letter with rules and regulation prescribed by law and government agencies for health, safety, and progress of the community.
 (f) Members shall be alert to examine proposed or enacted State and Local legislation detrimental to social, economic and political progress.
 (g) Members shall not perform, or cause to be performed, any act which would tend to reflect on, or bring into disrepute, any part of the home building industry.
